As a Christian this will be an experience of a life time and one of the best journeys you will ever take.

Things needed for your travels to Israel

1) Passport, no visa - Make a copy of the passport - keep separate

2) Written copy of medicine currently taking

3) No dress up clothes needed

4) Take layered clothing - outer garments can be worn more than one day

a. Blue jeans/slacks

b Long sleeve shirts

c. Good walking shoes

d. Umbrella

e. Light jacket with hood if you have

f Heavier jacket or sweater for cooler temperature.

g. Gloves

h. Hat, scarf, or some sort of head covering for the cooler weather.

5) For those wishing to be baptized in the Jordan

- a. Bring a bathing suit or clothes that are dirty or/and
- b. Use the clothes you wore on the plane ride over
- c. White (thin) robes are provided - need something underneath
- d. Cost for baptism robes, towels, and use of changing place - \$8.00/person

6) Money (1 Jordanian Dinar = \$1.41 ; 1 Shekel = \$ 0.2830)

- a. 25, one dollar bills
- b. 300-400 dollars in smaller bills - 5-10-20's
 - i. Change will be returned in shekels
 - ii. Most places will ship large purchases home for you.
- c. Every place takes credit cards and personal checks

d. Your credit card company could charge you extra for using your credit card in Israel.

e. All expenses are paid except for noon meals and love offering for driver and guide at the end of the trip and for guide if we go into Bethlehem & Jordan. (\$7.50/day/person)

7) Camera with extra batteries.

8) Cell phones, if taken check for overseas calling before leaving states.

9) Computers if needed, will cost for internet connection

10) Motels have hair driers

a. Electricity is 220 with 50 cycle, need an adapter at some motels, some have 110 in the bath room.

b. For the ladies, motels normally do not provide wash clothes, so if you need something to remove makeup, bring something with you.

11) Bibles, recording device, notepads or good memory.

12) Weight limit on airplanes will depend on the aircraft used.

13) If you purchase too many items while in Israel, most motels will keep your extra clothes and give to orphanages, so you can get your new purchases home.

14) Anything you need while on this trip, other than money, please see me. I will handle all situations should they arise. We have never had any issues but one never knows. I don't want you worrying about a situation, let me do that.

15) Once you receive your tickets, normally two to three weeks before the flight date, call the airline to ensure your seating arrangement, example spouse together. Sometimes in group booking the airline does not do a good job on getting people together.

16) Stay together through the Old City and keep your kids with you.

17) We really have a full schedule this year so we are going to have to keep moving. If you have something to say at a site, consider waiting until we get on the bus.
